PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION “ENTENG” WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 510 EAST OF BALER, AURORA (16.1 °N, 126.3 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 45KM/HR NEAR CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 55 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTH AT 10KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON, VISAYAS, AND MINDANAO

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned **are advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.**

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to reiterate the guidelines on personal protection and hygiene such as respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene, social distancing, environmental, and food safety measures.

Let’s untiringly aim for zero casualty.
