PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "ENTENG" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 500 KM EAST OF TUGUEGARAO CITY, CAGAYAN (18.2 °N, 126.2 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 55 KM/HR NEAR CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 70 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTH NORTHEASTWARD AT 15 KM/H. MEANWHILE, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATE AT 260 KM WEST OF IBA, ZAMBALES (14.9 °N, 117.6 °E). SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON, VISAYAS, AND MINDANAO.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to reiterate the guidelines on personal protection and hygiene such as respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene, social distancing, environmental, and food safety measures.
