### **PRESENT WEATHER:**

**AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 285 KM WEST NORTHWEST OF SUBIC, ZAMBALES OR 250 KM WEST OF DAGUPAN CITY, PANGASINAN (16.1 °N, 118.0 °E). SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON AND WESTERN VISAYAS. TROPICAL STORM JANGMI (FORMERLY "ENTENG"), AT 3:00 PM, WAS LOCATED AT 730 KM NORTHEAST OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (25.8 °N, 126.1 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 75 KPH AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 90 KPH. IT WAS MOVING NORTH AT 40 KPH.**
