PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 90 KM WEST NORTHWEST OF CALAYAN, CAGAYAN (19.6 °N, 120.7 °E). MEANWHILE, ANOTHER LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 315 KM EAST SOUTHEAST OF HINATUAN, SURIGAO DEL SUR (7.7 °N, 129.1 °E). SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTIONS OF SOUTHERN LUZON, VISAYAS, AND MINDANAO.
