PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "IGME" (I.N. BAVI) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 470 KM NORTH NORTHEAST OF BASCO, BATANES (24.5°N, 123.3°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 95 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 115 KM/H. IT IS FORECAST TO MOVE NORTH NORTHEASTWARD AT 20 KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING WESTERN SECTION OF LUZON.
