### PRESENT WEATHER:

**AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "ENTENG" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 500 KM EAST OF TUGUEGARAO CITY, CAGAYAN (18.2 °N, 126.2 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 55 KM/HR NEAR CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 70 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTH NORTHEASTWARD AT 15 KM/H. MEANWHILE, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATE AT 260 KM WEST OF IBA, ZAMBALES (14.9 °N, 117.6 °E). SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON, VISAYAS, AND MINDANAO.**
