PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "DINDO" (I.N. HAGUPIT) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 470 KM NORTH NORTHEAST OF BASCO, BATANES (24.3°N, 123.8°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 95 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 115 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWESTWARD AT 15 KM/H. MEANWHILE, A LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 570 KM EAST SOUTHEAST OF DAVAO CITY (5.9°N, 130.8°E). SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON.

AGUSAN DEL NORTE - particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran. SURIGAO DEL SUR - particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan, and Bislig.
