<b>AWARENESS INFORMATION/ ADVISORY</b>	<p>Generally, <b>light to moderate rains and chances of thunderstorm activities will be experienced over Davao River Basin.</b></p> <p>Residents and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction And Management Councils (LDRRMCs) adjacent to and/or along the above-mentioned areas of concern are <b>still</b> advised to maintain their vigilance and <b>take appropriate</b> precautionary measures to mitigate impacts of possible <b>flashfloods</b>, landslides, and river floods within Davao River Basin, and to continue monitor the updates particularly Thunderstorm Advisory issued by Mindanao PAGASA Regional Services Division.</p>
