Final Report on the Whirlwind Incident in Tudela, Misamis Occidental (Region X)

A. Situation Overview

 On 05 August 2020, at 4:00PM, a whirlwind incident occurred in the Municipality of Tudela, Misamis Occidental.

B. EFFECTS

- A total of **110 families / 433 persons** were affected due to the incident.
- A total of 4 persons were injured.
