STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

SEABOARDS	WEATHER	WIND FORCE (KPH /KNOTS)	SEA CONDITION	WAVE HEIGHT (meters)
THE NORTHERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Babuyan, and northern coast of Ilocos Norte)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON (Ilocos Sur and western coast of Ilocos Norte)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers and thunderstorms	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
