PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM "LEON" (NOUL) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 405 KM WEST NORTHWEST OF CORON, PALAWAN (13.2 °N, 116.7 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 75 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 90 KM/H. IT IS MOVING WESTWARD AT 15 KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING PALAWAN, VISAYAS, AND MINDANAO.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to reiterate the guidelines on personal protection and hygiene such as respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene, social distancing, environmental, and food safety measures.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
