Incident Report No. 02 re Flash Flood due to Continuous Rainfall in Palimbang, Sultan Kudarat Province (REGION XII)

INCIDENT	Flash Flood
DATE & TIME OF INCIDENT	15 September 2020, at around 5:00 PM
LOCATION	Municipality of Palimbang, Sultan Kudarat Province
OVERVIEW	On 15 September 2020, at around 5:00 PM, continuous moderate to heavy pour of rain was experienced in the Municipality of Palimbang due to localized thunderstorm, resulting to swelling of Badiangan River.
	 AFFECTED POPULATION 250 families/1,125 individuals were evacuated to Poblacion Covered Court. Of which, 145 families already returned home as the floodwaters subsided in their areas while 105 families remain in the evacuation area.
EFFECTS	 MISSING Two (2) persons went missing as they were swept away by strong water from the Badiangan River to Celebes Sea. DAMAGED HOUSES 65 houses (22-totally / 45-partially) were damaged. ROADS AND BRIDGES The bridge located at Brgy Badiangan was damaged thus, impassable to all vehicles. Bridge Abutment in Domulol was partially damaged, but still passable. Fallen branches, uprooted trees, toppled electrical posts along Palimban Southern Road. Rain induced landslide on Palimban Northern Road. STATUS OF LINES Power outage in the northern part of the Municipality of Palimbang due to toppled electric posts. Power has been

	restored after 24 hours. Meanwhile, electricity and cellular networks are now functional.
	PCG, 37th IB PA, Army Reservist, Brgy Poblacion BPAT, Palimbang Search and Rescue Group • Conducted search and retrieval operations for the missing persons.
	 PDRRMO Sultan Kudarat Deployed personnel to assist the MDRRMO Palimbang and conducted validation. Provincial government, PHO, PDRRMO, PSWDO provided reliefs/food packs, psychological assistance, and medicine, hygiene kits to the IDPs
ACTIONS TAKEN	 MDRRMO Palimbang Deployed search and rescue groups and volunteers to evacuate the affected families. Provided food, cash assistance, medical assistance and psychological support to the affected families
	LGU Palimbang Provided food and non-food items to IDPs and affected families.
	BDRRMC Conducted damage assessment together with MDRRMC Palimbang.
