



RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CONDUCT OF POST DISASTER NEEDS ASSESSMENT (PDNA) IN RELATION TO THE EFFECTS OF TYPHOONS QUINTA, ROLLY, AND ULYSSES AND THE DESIGNATION OF LEAD PER SECTOR/SUBSECTOR

NDRRMC RESOLUTION NO. 07, s 2020

WHEREAS, from 23 October to 13 November 2020, the Philippines was ravaged by three typhoons: Quinta, Rolly and Ulysses, leaving behind extensive losses and damages in the all over Luzon and some parts of the Visayas;

WHEREAS, the total Affected Population includes: 1,934,670 Affected Families; 7,863,826 Total Affected Individuals with 150 deaths, 524 reported injuries and 20 missing. These typhoons also damaged 454,234 houses; P26,443,156,713.78 worth of damage to infrastructure and a total of P 14,988,107,964.00 worth of damage to crops, livestock, fisheries and agricultural facilities;

WHEREAS, considering that the full extent of the losses and damages are not yet fully validated, there is an exigent need for a detailed assessment and validation of the impact of from these typhoons;

WHEREAS, a detailed assessment is a requisite for a detailed recovery and rehabilitation planning for the affected sectors in the various typhoon-affected regions;

WHEREAS, Section 9(m) of the Republic Act 10121 states that the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) shall "Conduct early recovery and Post-Disaster Needs Assessment institutionalizing gender analysis as part of it.";

WHEREAS, in consideration of the necessity to immediately implement the necessary interventions the conduct of PDNA and RRP shall strictly follow the approved timeline set forth and present to the Build Back Better Task Force (BBB TF) on or before 28 January 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council **RESOLVES**, and it is hereby **RESOLVED** to direct the conduct of PDNA and the subsequent preparation of the respective **Rehabilitation and Recovery Plans (RRPs)** for all the Typhoons Quinta, Rolly, and Ulysses affected areas.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the regional offices shall be the Sectors and Subsectors as leads of the respective PDNAs using the WB PDNA Guidance Notes; and the OCD shall be the overall lead:
