**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NATIONAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND
MANAGEMENT FRAMEWORK AND PLAN 2020-2030
AND RECOMMENDING THE ISSUANCE OF A DIRECTIVE BY THE OFFICE OF
THE PRESIDENT ON ITS ADOPTION**

NDRRMC RESOLUTION NO. 08, s. 2020

WHEREAS, Section 2(d) of Republic Act No. 10121 provides that it shall be the policy of the State to adopt a disaster risk reduction and management (DRRM) approach that is holistic, comprehensive, integrated, and proactive in lessening the socioeconomic and environmental impacts of disasters, including climate change, and promote the involvement and participation of all sectors and all stakeholders concerned, at all levels, especially the local community;

WHEREAS, Section 2(e) of Republic Act No. 10121 provides that it shall be the policy of the State to develop, promote, and implement a comprehensive National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (NDRRMP) that aims to strengthen the capacity of the national government and the local government units (LGUs), together with partner stakeholders, to build the disaster resilience of communities, and to institutionalize arrangements and measures for reducing disaster risks, including projected climate risks, and enhancing disaster preparedness and response capabilities at all levels;

WHEREAS, Section 2(g) of Republic Act No. 10121 provides that it shall be the policy of the State to mainstream disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation (CCA) in development processes such as policy formulation, socioeconomic development planning, budgeting, and governance, particularly in the areas of environment, agriculture, water, energy, health, education, poverty reduction, land use and urban planning, and public infrastructure and housing, among others;

WHEREAS, Section 6(a) of Republic Act 10121 provides that the NDRRMC shall develop an NDRRM Framework which shall provide for a comprehensive, all-hazards, multi-sectoral, inter-agency and community-based approach to DRRM. The Framework shall serve as the principal guide to DRRM efforts in the country and shall be reviewed on a five-year interval, or as may be deemed necessary, in order to ensure its relevance to the times;

WHEREAS, the NDRRMP shall provide for the identification of hazards, vulnerabilities and risks to be managed at the national level; DRRM approaches and strategies to be applied in managing said hazards and risks; agency roles, responsibilities, and lines of authority at all government levels; and vertical and horizontal coordination of DRRM in the pre-disaster and post-disaster phases. It shall be in conformity with the NDRRM Framework;

WHEREAS, in 2011, the NDRRMC approved and adopted the NDRRM Framework and the NDRRM Plan 2011-2028, aligned with the Hyogo Framework for Action (HFA) and the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), which serve as the principal guide to DRRM efforts with a vision of “safer, adaptive, and disaster-resilient Filipino communities toward sustainable development.”;

WHEREAS, in 2015, the country adopted the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction (SFDRR) and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), being the successor of the HFA and the MDGs, respectively;

WHEREAS, to ensure its relevance with new global frameworks on DRR and with the changing risk landscape, the NDRRMP 2020-2030 was formulated in consultation with key agencies and instrumentalities of the government and with participation of representatives of all other stakeholders – including the academe and non-governmental organizations – taking into account the lessons learned, good practices, as well as, the challenges in the implementation of NDRRMP 2011-2028;

WHEREAS, the NDRRMP 2020-2030 establishes the linkage between DRRM, CCA, and human security by focusing on climate and disaster risks to achieve the shared goals of Ambisyon Natin 2040, NDRRMP, National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP) and National Security Strategy (NSS) in risk reduction, resilience building, human security, and sustainable development;

WHEREAS, on 28 October 2020, having been endorsed by all the four (4) NDRRMC clusters, the NDRRMC Technical Management Group approved to endorse the NDRRMP 2020-2030 to the National Council for approval;

WHEREAS, on 30 October 2020, the NDRRMC Full Council took up the proposed enhanced National DRRM Framework and Plan 2020-2030;

NOW, THEREFORE, the NDRRMC **RESOLVES** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to:

- 1) Approve the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Framework and Plan 2020-2030;
- 2) Have the NDRRMP 2020-2030 disseminated to the members of the NDRRMC, Regional and Local DRRMCs, heads of national agencies, constitutional offices, State Universities and Colleges (SUCs), Government Owned and Controlled Corporations (GOCCs), Provincial Governors, City and Municipal Mayors, members of the local Sanggunian, local finance committees, and representatives of all stakeholders for its immediate implementation;
- 3) Direct the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) to lead the establishment and implementation of a Monitoring and Evaluation system to ensure the proper and effective implementation of the NDRRMP 2020-2030 and shall provide technical assistance to the LGUs, NGAs, SUCs, and GOCCs as necessary to ensure its implementation; and

- 4) Recommend to the Office of the President the issuance of a directive to all government agencies to adopt the NDRRMP 2020-2030 in the formulation and implementation of their respective DRRM plans and programs.


