



**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND
MANAGEMENT MONITORING AND EVALUATION (DRRM M&E) SITUATIONAL
ANALYSIS AND GAPS ASSESSMENT STUDY INCLUDING ALL ITS
RECOMMENDATIONS**

NDRRMC RESOLUTION NO. 8, s. 2021

WHEREAS, Section 2(e) of Republic Act No. 10121 provides that it shall be the policy of the State to develop, promote, and implement a comprehensive National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (NDRRMP) that aims to strengthen the capacity of the national government and the local government units (LGUs), together with partner stakeholders, to build the disaster resilience of communities, and to institutionalize arrangements and measures for reducing disaster risks, including projected climate risks, and enhancing disaster preparedness and response capabilities at all levels;

WHEREAS, the NDRRMP 2020-2030 establishes the linkage between DRRM, CCA, and human security by focusing on climate and disaster risks to achieve the shared goals of Ambisyon Natin 2040, NDRRMP, National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP) and National Security Strategy (NSS) in risk reduction, resilience building, human security, and sustainable development;

WHEREAS, on 30 October 2020, the NDRRMC Full Council approved the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Framework and Plan (NDRRMP) 2020 – 2030;

WHEREAS, the NDRRMC recognizes the gaps in monitoring and evaluation (M&E), hence the approval of the NDRRMP 2020 - 2030 which sets a direction toward establishing a Results-Based Monitoring and Evaluation System (RBMES);

WHEREAS, the NDRRMC recognized that the RBMES will track not only the progress of implementation of planned activities, but more importantly, monitor progress towards the intended outputs and outcomes outlined in the updated policy document. Furthermore, it would demonstrate accountability and transparency, ensure that tangible outputs are achieved in a timely and efficient manner as well as show results;

WHEREAS, as a starting point in developing the RBMES Framework and Plan, a DRRM M&E Situational Analysis and Gaps Assessment was carried out from May to July 2021, enjoining seven hundred ninety (790) DRRM stakeholders in the country to identify the strengths and weaknesses in the Philippines' DRRM M&E system and practice and agree on the actions needed to enhance its M&E system performance;

WHEREAS, on 09 September 2021, during the 3rd Quarter NDRRMC TMG Meeting CY 2021, the NDRRMC TMG approved the endorsement of the DRRM M&E Situational Analysis and Gaps Assessment Study Findings and Recommendations to the NDRRMC Full Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, the NDRRMC **RESOLVES** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to adopt the recommendations of the study enclosed in this resolution and for the study to serve as a basis in developing the M&E Framework and Plan, and M&E web-based system of the NDRRMP 2020-2030.
