NDRRMC RESOLUTION NO. 10, s. 2022

RESOLUTION ON THE CONSTRUCTION OF TEMPORARY SHELTERS FOR FAMILIES AFFECTED BY LANDSLIDES IN ABUYOG AND BAYBAY CITY, LEYTE DUE TO TROPICAL CYCLONE AGATON

WHEREAS, Section 2(I) of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010," provides that it shall be the policy of the State to recognize and strengthen the capacities of LGUs and communities in mitigating and preparing for, responding to, and recovering from the impact of disasters;

WHEREAS, Section 2(p) of Republic Act No. 10121 provides that it shall be the policy of the State to provide maximum care, assistance and services to individuals and families affected by disaster, implement emergency rehabilitation projects to lessen the impact of disaster, and facilitate resumption of normal social and economic activities;

WHEREAS, from 09 to 12 April 2022, Tropical Cyclone (TC) AGATON hit the country, causing 826 flooded areas and 123 other related incidents in several localities. Among the hard hit areas are Baybay City and Abuyog in Leyte, in which a Declaration of a State of Calamity was made on 11 and 12 April 2022 in the said localities, respectively, due to the impacts of flooding and landslides;

WHEREAS, during the President's visit in Baybay City on 15 April 2022, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) has been instructed to construct temporary shelters for Abuyog and Baybay City, and relocate families;

WHEREAS, based on the series of meetings of the NDRRMC and Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (RDRRMC) VIII, agencies have been assigned to perform priority tasks to facilitate construction of temporary shelters;

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) as the lead for Shelter Cluster shall propose and implement permanent and standard shelter program;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council RESOLVES, as it hereby RESOLVED, for the following agencies to prioritize the implementation of their respective tasks to facilitate the construction of temporary shelters for families affected by landslides in Abuyog and Baybay City, Leyte due to TC AGATON:

- Office of Civil Defense (OCD) shall provide materials for the construction of temporary shelters;
- Department of Environment and Natural Resources-Mines and Geosciences Bureau

(DENR-MGB) shall continuously conduct assessment of landslide affected areas and recommend possible relocation sites;

- Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) shall provide support in the site inspection, preparation and development;
- Department of Social Work and Development (DSWD) shall provide food/cash for work for volunteers and other workers involved in the construction of temporary shelters;
- Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) shall ensure compliance of Baybay and Abuyog Local Government Units (LGU) in the relocation of affected families;
- Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) shall deploy personnel for the construction of shelters; and
- Local Government of Baybay City and Abuyog, Leyte shall provide sites for relocation of affected families
