



RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CONDUCT OF POST-DISASTER NEEDS ASSESSMENT (PDNA) IN REGION IVB (MIMAROPA), REGION VI (WESTERN VISAYAS REGION), REGION VII (CENTRAL VISAYAS REGION), REGION VIII (EASTERN VISAYAS REGION), REGION X (NORTHERN MINDANAO), AND REGION XIII (CARAGA) RELATIVE TO THE ONSLAUGHT OF TYPHOON ODETTE

NDRRMC RESOLUTION NO. 12 s.2021

WHEREAS, from 16 to 19 December 2021, Typhoon ODETTE hit the country, affecting Region IVB (MIMAROPA), Region VI (Western Visayas Region), Region VII (Central Visayas Region), Region VIII (Eastern Visayas Region), Region X (Northern Mindanao), and Region XIII (CARAGA), among others, leading to the following consolidated indicative number of affected population¹ in need of emergency assistance:

Region IVB (MIMAROPA)	18,856 individuals
Region VI (Western Visayas Region)	416,988 individuals
Region VII (Central Visayas Region)	80,694 individuals
Region VIII (Eastern Visayas Region)	244,741 individuals
Region X (Northern Mindanao)	22,463 individuals
Region XIII (CARAGA)	217,080 individuals

WHEREAS, the NDRRMC determined that all the identified regions meet the requirements and subsequently issued a resolution for a declaration of a State of Calamity;

WHEREAS, considering that the full extent of the losses and damages are not yet fully validated, there is an exigent need for a detailed assessment and validation of the impact of Typhoon Odette;

WHEREAS, a detailed assessment is a requisite for a detailed recovery and rehabilitation planning for the affected sectors in the various typhoon-affected regions;

WHEREAS, Section 9(m) of the Republic Act 10121 states that the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) shall "Conduct early recovery and Post-Disaster Needs Assessment institutionalizing gender analysis as part of it.";

WHEREAS, the timeline in the conduct of PDNA and the preparation of the Rehabilitation and Recovery Programs shall be from 20 December 2021 to 31 January 2022 for consideration in the FY 2022 NDRRM Fund and to coincide with the preparation of the FY 2023 National Expenditure Program;

WHEREAS, in consideration of the necessity to immediately implement the necessary interventions, the conduct of PDNA and RRP shall strictly follow the approved timeline set forth to conduct the PDNA and present to the Council on or before 18 February 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council **RESOLVES**, and it is hereby **RESOLVED** to direct the conduct of PDNA and the subsequent preparation of the respective **Rehabilitation and Recovery Programs (RRPs)** for the typhoon-affected areas of Region IVB (MIMAROPA), Region VI (Western Visayas Region), Region VII (Central Visayas Region), Region VIII (Eastern Visayas Region), Region X (Northern Mindanao), and Region XIII (CARAGA).

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the regional offices shall be the Sectors and Subsectors as leads of the respective PDNAs using the WB PDNA Guidance Notes; and the OCD shall be the overall lead and the participation of CSOs and other agencies are encouraged:
