TO : CHAIRPERSONS OF RDRRMCs / OCD REGIONAL DIRECTORS I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VIII, CAR and NCR

SUBJECT : **Agreements during the Meeting on 16 November 2020 ICOW Combined Effects and Damages of TY QUINTA, STY ROLLY and TY ULYSSES**

With reference to the instructions of the OCD Administrator / NDRRMC Executive Director during the meeting on 16 November 2020 via video teleconferencing, the Chairpersons of RDRRMCs/ OCD Regional Directors of Regions I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VIII, CAR and NCR are hereby directed to undertake the following actions in connection with the combined effects of Typhoon QUINTA, Super typhoon ROLLY and Typhoon ULYSSES:

1. Conduct joint assessment of Local Government Units (LGUs) requiring Emergency Shelter Assistance (ESA) in coordination with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD); submit consolidated cost estimates for ESA per affected LGU to the OCD Operations Service **not later than 20 November 2020**.
2. Submit report on affected population and number of evacuees, disaggregated into cities/municipalities, to be reflected in the subsequent RDRRMC Situational Report;
3. Ensure proper Incident Command System (ICS) application and avoid further casualties on the part of the responders and the general public;
4. Centralize public information releases within the RDRRMC EOC;
 - a. Organize a virtual joint information center (JIC) to be joined by all public information officers (PIO) led by the Philippine Information Officer (PIA);
 - b. Inform uniformed agencies and other offices that the published information and other reports are still subject to validation and consolidation at the RDRRMC level;
5. Strengthen the Regional Response Clusters and remind concerned agencies to follow the DRRMC reporting channels;
6. Remind LGUs to execute forced evacuation if needed, pursuant to Rule 5, IRR of RA 10121
7. Conduct joint inter-agency Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA)
8. Coordinate with dam management regarding schedules of water release and submit recommendations to OCD Operations Center on the use of Emergency Alert and Warning Message (EAWM)
