SUBJECT : Advisory on the Decontamination of the NDRRM
Operations Center


The National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is due for decontamination starting today, 29 March 2020. As such, the NDRRMOC will be closed and inaccessible on the said day. You will be advised accordingly on the resumption of its use.

As a precautionary measure, all NDRRMOC duty personnel of the aforementioned agencies are hereby advised to observe a mandatory 14-day home quarantine starting today. During this time you are to observe for the manifestation of CoViD-19 symptoms such as fever, dry cough, shortness of breath or tiredness, and diarrhea. Seek prompt medical attention if any one of these symptoms persists.

Further, you are advised to practice protective measures such as frequent handwashing or use of alcohol-based sanitizer if soap and water are not available, practice proper cough etiquette, and maintain distance of at least one meter away from individuals experiencing respiratory symptoms.
