Request for Comments and Recommendations on the

Updated Implementing Guidelines and Procedures (IGP) for

the National Service Reserve Corps (NSRC)

To operationalize the mobilization of National Service Reserve Corps (NSRC), the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) has issued its Implementing Guidelines and Procedures (IGP) in 2012, which remained as the primary reference for NSRC implementation. With the recent disasters that hit the country, there is a need to maximize the role of the NSRC and how the operating units can be mobilized across all thematic areas of DRRM. However, given the new and emerging DRRM concerns, some of the provisions of the existing NSRC IGP are rendered outdated. Thus, the NSRC IGP needs to be reviewed and updated.

In this regard, all members of the National Service Training Program (NSTP) - NSRC Technical Working Group, all NDRRMC Member Agencies, OCD Services and Regional Offices are hereby requested to submit comments on the draft of updated NSRC IGP to the OCD CBTS via ocdndrrmctraining2020@gmail.com, not later than 4 September 2020. Non-submission of comments and recommendations will be taken as concurrence on the said draft.
