**SUBJECT : CASCADING OF AGREEMENTS DURING THE  
NDRRMC EMERGENCY FULL COUNCIL MEETING  
ON 06 NOVEMBER 2020**

This NDRRMC Memorandum is hereby issued to cascade the agreements during the NDRRMC Full Council Meeting on 06 November 2020 relative to the effects and damages of Typhoon (TY) Quinta and Super Typhoon (STY) Rolly:

Expansion of the Philippine Humanitarian Assistance Registry (PHAR) platform for monitoring of donations for both COVID-19 and other disasters; all agencies receiving donations for their response related to TY Quinta and STY Rolly (except those of nominal value as per Administrative Order No. 27 s 2020) to report the same to OCD for entry in the PHAR	DFA DICT OCD All NDRRMC member agencies
Processing and acceptance of international offers of assistance to typhoon affected areas	DFA OCD
Enhancement of communication systems between the local government units (LGUs) and the regional / national line agencies in times of disasters through the expansion of the Government Emergency Communications System (GECS) project and the need for investment of LGUs on ICT related programs	DICT DILG
Rationalization of programming of expenditures using the Quick Response Funds (QRF) and explore options for augmentation of funds used in disaster response and early recovery activities	All NDRRMC member agencies with QRF allocation
Reporting of current status of Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Funds (LDRRMF) and recommendation for possible augmentation for the same	DILG
Provision of training and alternative livelihood programs for communities such as the community-based hollow block making	TESDA DTI DOLE

Enhancement of the resilience of local water systems through investments in mobile water treatment facilities	LWUA
Conduct of Post-Disaster Needs Assessment (PDNA) to typhoon affected areas for long-term rehabilitation and recovery plans under the	NEDA OCD
