SUBJECT : Preparedness Actions based on Agreements during
NDRRMC Emergency Meeting on 09 November 2020
ICOW TD ULYSSES

Based on the results of the NDRRMC Emergency Meeting conducted on 09 November 2020 via video teleconferencing, the Chairpersons of RDRRMCs/ OCD Regional Directors of Regions III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII and NCR are hereby directed to undertake the following preparedness actions in connection with Tropical Depression (TD) ULYSSES and other associated hazards:

1. Convene the RDRRMC and conduct Regional Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA), as necessary;
2. Coordinate with DILG for the LDRRMCs to conduct respective local PDRA and undertake preparedness and response protocols based on Operation LISTO;
3. Use primary and backup systems to communicate alerts and warning messages, especially the directives to conduct pre-emptive and/or forced evacuation procedures, as needed; and
4. Submit regular RDRRMC Situation Report in case of event escalation, highlighting the current situation, summary of damages and response needs, to the NDRRMC Emergency Operations Center (EOC).

Further, the uniformed offices (AFP, PNP, BFP and PCG), DILG, PCOO and information officers of the NDRRMC member agencies are hereby enjoined to cascade the general warning message for TD ULYSSES (see attached) for widest dissemination to all barangays, especially those with no access to electricity and internet connection, using backup radio communication systems and other improvised and community-based early warning tools/systems.

Inaabisuhan at pinag-iingat ang mga nakatira lalo na sa baybayin at mababang lugar ng Metro Manila, Central Luzon, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, Bicol Region, at nang buong ka-Bisayaan mula sa banta ng bagyong si ULYSSES. Ang Bagyong ULYSSES ay inaasahang tatahakin ang katimugang Luzon sa pagitan ng Bicol at probinsya ng Quezon. Ito ay tinatayang magdudulot ng malakas na pag-ulan at pabugso-bugsong hangin na maaring maging sanhi ng pagbaha, storm surge o daluyong at pagguho ng lupa.

Iwasan ang paglalayag ng maliliit na bangka sa mga lugar na NAKATAAS ang Gale Warning. Sumunod sa ipinatutupad na evacuation ng inyong barangay, munisipyo o siyudad. Maaring MAKIPAG-UGNAYAN sa malapit na lokal na pamahalaan kung saan ligtas na lumikas. Lahat ay PINAG-IINGAT. MAGING MAPAGMATYAG AT INGATAN ANG SARILI AT PAMILYA.

SA MGA AHENSYA NG GOBYERNO AT LOKAL NA PAMAHALAAN: Siguraduhing ang mga abiso ay makararating sa buong pamayanan lalo na sa mga nakaranas ng sunod-sunod na pag-ulan.
