**SUBJECT: Request for Comments and Recommendations on the
Directives on the Establishment and Management of COVID-
19 Sensitive Evacuation Centers**

Amidst this ongoing public health emergency brought about by Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), there is a need to continuously strengthen disaster preparedness initiatives in the country to combat the risks and threats of natural hazards. In line with this, there is a need to provide clear guidelines for the establishment and management of evacuation centers. On this end, the OCD, through the CBTS, has drafted the directives on the establishment and management of COVID-19 sensitive evacuation centers.
