TO : National Response Clusters Leads and Member Agencies

SUBJECT : Standby Alert in relation to Severe Tropical Storm "Auring"

In preparation to the effects of Severe Tropical Storm "Auring" in the country the following National Response Clusters are advised to prepare and place on standby their resources for possible augmentation to the affected areas:

1. Food and Non-Food Items (DSWD)
2. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (DSWD)
3. Internally Displaced Persons Protection (DSWD)
4. Health (DOH)
5. Logistics (OCD)
6. Emergency Telecommunications (OCD)
7. Search, Rescue and Retrieval (AFP)

As such, all Cluster Leads are enjoined to coordinate with their respective Cluster Members and convene using all possible communication means. Further, Cluster Leads are directed to submit their Daily Essential Elements of Information (EEI) to the Operations Service, Office of Civil Defense via rocd@ocd.gov.ph, per NDRRMC Memo No. 109, s. 2020, copy of which is attached for reference.

Lastly, a Virtual EOC will be set-up and hosted by the 24/7 OpCen, OCD. It will serve as information hub as well as coordination means where you may send and receive information pertaining to the possible response operations. Below are the connection details:
