PROTOCOLS ICOW TS DANTE

With reference to the agreements during the Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) Meeting for Tropical Storm DANTE conducted on 31 May 2021, 1600H, the NDRRMC Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) Protocol is hereby activated to BRAVO.

In this regard, all NDRRMC member agencies are hereby directed to undertake the following:
