SUBJECT : EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE
 PROTOCOLS ICOW TS DANTE

With reference to the agreements during the Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) Meeting for Tropical Storm DANTE conducted on 31 May 2021, 1600H, the NDRRMC Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) Protocol is hereby activated to **BRAVO**.

In this regard, all NDRRMC member agencies are hereby directed to undertake the following:
