Roles of OCD in COVID-19 Response and Recovery Interventions as part of National Action Plan Phase III

With reference to Republic Act 11494, otherwise known as "Bayanihan to Heal As One Act," and the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) Resolution No. 76 s. 2020, the National Task Force (NTF) Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) is now in the process of sustaining the efforts for national response and recovery through the National Action Plan (NAP) Phase III.

In this connection, the following Services and Office are hereby directed to undertake the following roles for COVID-19 response and recovery interventions, as agreed during the OCD Management Committee Meeting on 07 October 2020:
