Raising of the Alert Status to Red of the NDRRMOC

effective 6:00 PM, 08 April 2022 in connection with the LPA

East of Surigao City

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 375 km East of Surigao City (10.2°N, 128.9°E). The development of this LPA into a tropical depression is not ruled out. It is embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Visayas and Mindanao. In the next 24 hours, the LPA will bring moderate to heavy rains over Catanduanes, Albay, Sorsogon, Eastern Visayas, Surigao del Norte, Agusan del Norte, the northern portion of Surigao del Sur, and Dinagat Islands.

In this regard, the Alert Status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is raised to RED effective 6:00 PM, 08 April 2022 to closely monitor, consolidate, and report all related incidents and to ensure prompt coordination with concerned agencies and offices.

Further, RDRRMCs are instructed to follow the checklist of actions from the Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) Protocols based on the activated category of their respective regions from the PDRA Core group and to send preparedness measures and update thru our **NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard**.
