**Activated**

1. Logistics (OCD)
2. Food and Non-Food Items (DSWD)
3. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (DSWD)
4. Internally Displaced Persons Protection (DSWD)
5. Health (DOH)
6. Law and Order (PNP)

**On Standby / As Need Arises**

1. Emergency Telecommunications (DICT)
2. Management of the Dead and Missing (DILG)
3. Philippine International Humanitarian Assistance (DFA)
4. Search, Rescue and Retrieval (AFP)
5. Education (DepEd)
6. Shelter (DHSUD)

In light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, Response Clusters are not required to render duty at the NDRRMC Emergency Operations Center. As such, Cluster Leads are enjoined to coordinate with their respective Cluster Members and convene using all available means.
