SUBJECT : EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE PROTOCOLS ICOW TROPICAL DEPRESSION AGATON AND OTHER WEATHER DISTURBANCE

With reference to the agreements during the Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) Meeting for Tropical Depression "AGATON" and other weather disturbances conducted on 09 April 2022, the NDRRMC Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) Protocol is hereby maintained to **CHARLIE PROTOCOL**.

Further, the following RDRRMCS are directed to maintain/activate the following EPR Protocols:

RDRRMC	EPR Protocol
CAR, I, III, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, CARAGA	CHARLIE Protocol
CALABARZON, XI, XII, BARMM	BRAVO Protocol
NCR, II	Standby Protocol

The activation of EPR Protocols shall be effective immediately. It is understood that the EPR Protocols shall be subject to change based on updates on the hazard situation and risk levels.

Attached herewith is the checklist of actions for the above EPR Protocols.
