Raising of the Alert Status to Red of the NDRRMOC

effective 27 July 2022 in connection with the Magnitude 7.0

Earthquake in Tayum, Abra

At 8:43 AM today, a magnitude 7.0 earthquake occurred in 17.64°N, 120.63°E - 003 km N 45° W of Tayum (Abra) with a depth of 017 km and tectonic in origin.

In this regard, the Alert Status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is raised to RED effective 27 July 2022 to closely monitor, consolidate, and report all related incidents and to ensure prompt coordination with concerned agencies and offices.

Further, RDRRMCs I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, CAR, AND NCR are instructed to follow the checklist of actions from the Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) Protocols and to send preparedness measures and update thru our NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard.
