PREPARATIONS FOR THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA)

OVER THE COASTAL WATERS OF QUEZON

Based on the Weather Update conducted on 05 August 2022, 1:00 PM, the LPA was estimated based on all available data over the coastal waters of Mauban, Quezon (14.4°N, 121.9°E). The development of this weather disturbance into a Tropical Depression is less likely within the next 24 hours.

In this connection, all Chairpersons of RDRRMCs/ OCD Regional Directors are hereby directed to undertake the following preparedness actions in connection with the said Low Pressure Area:

- Monitor closely the warning and other advisories issued by DOST-PAGASA, DENR-MGB, and other surveillance agencies. Cross validate the current situation with the Doppler radar images, satellite images, and other science-based monitoring and forecasting tools;
- Initiate Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) at the regional level. Further, coordinate
 with the DILG for the LDRRMCs to conduct respective local PDRA and undertake
 preparedness based on Operation LISTO;
- 3. Strengthen risk communication and localize the warning to communities within respective areas of responsibility;
- Ensure adherence to the NDRRMC's guidelines on COVID-19 Preparedness Measures for the anticipated rainy season; and
- 5. Submit regular RDRRMC Situation Report, as needed, highlighting the current situation, preparedness measures, summary of damages, and response needs, to the NDRRM Operations Center.
