: MAINTAINING THE BLUE ALERT STATUS AT THE NATIONAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS CENTER (NDRRMOC) ICOW SUPER TYPHOON "HINNAMNOR" (OUTSIDE PAR)

EFFECTIVE 5:00 PM, 31 AUGUST 2022

Based on the advisories issued at 11:00 AM, 31 August 2022, Tropical Depression "GARDO" maintains its strength while moving northwestward east of extreme Northern Luzon while Super Typhoon "HINNAMNOR" maintains its strength while moving west southwestward over the sea east of Ryukyu Islands. Meanwhile, based on the 24-hour Public Weather Forecast issued at 4:00 PM, Metro Manila and the rest of the country will experience partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by Localized Thunderstorms. Possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

In view of the above, the alert status at the NDRRMOC is maintained to **BLUE Alert Status** effective **5:00 PM**, **31 August 2022**. As such, all OCDROs/Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Centers (RDRRMOCs) are hereby directed to closely monitor, consolidate and report all related incidents and to ensure prompt coordination with concerned agencies and offices.

Further, preparedness measures, respective response action plans, and any untoward incidents monitored regarding said event shall be submitted through the NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard.
