**SUBJECT : MAINTAINING OF BLUE ALERT STATUS AT THE
NATIONAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND
MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS CENTER (NDRRMOC)
ICOW CORONAVIRUS 2019 (COVID-19) DISEASE**



Based on the agreements during the NDRRMC Full Council Meeting on 05 September 2022, the Declaration of a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) shall be extended for a period of (6) months from 12 September 2022 to 13 March 2023, to be formalized through the issuance of a new Proclamation.

In view of the above, the alert status at the NDRRMOC is maintained to BLUE ALERT Status. As such, all OCDROs/RDRRMOCs are hereby directed to closely monitor, consolidate and report all related incidents and to ensure prompt coordination with concerned agencies and offices. Further, all OCDROs/RDRRMOCs are hereby directed to adhere with the operational arrangements for COVID-19 management, as provided for in OCD Office Order No. 039, s. 2022.

The BLUE ALERT Status shall be maintained until the Declaration of State of Calamity will be officially lifted.
