SUBJECT : Reminder re Immediate Restoration of Airports and
Seaports in Typhoon ODETTE Affected Areas

This NDRRMC Memorandum is issued in compliance with the directive of the President to sustain delivery of water, food and other relief items to all areas affected by Typhoon ODETTE. Based on the latest NDRRMC Situational Report, 2 airports and 65 seaports remain non-operational. Given that it has been more than a month since the devastation of the typhoon, it can be observed that the restoration of functionality of airports and seaports has been considerably slow in some areas. Such hampers the efficient delivery of water, food and other relief items to the communities.

In this connection, we would like to request your good office to ensure immediate restoration of airports and seaports; and work with the local government units (LGUs) to report updated status of ports to the OCD Regional Offices.
