SUBJECT :

Raising the Alert Status to RED of the NDRRMOC effective 6:00 PM, 23 September 2022 in connection with TS

"KARDING"

At 4:00 PM today, the center of the eye was estimated based on all available data 970 km East of Northern Luzon (17.7 °N, 130.9 °E) with maximum sustained winds of 75 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 90 km/h. It is moving Westward at 15 km/h.

With reference to the agreements during the Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment on 23 September 2022, 4:30 PM, the Alert Status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is raised to RED effective 6:00 PM, 23 September 2022 to closely monitor, consolidate, and report all related incidents and to ensure prompt coordination with concerned agencies and offices.

Further, RDRRMCs are instructed to follow the checklist of actions from the Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) Protocols based on the activated category of their respective regions from the PDRA Core group and to send preparedness measures and update thru our NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard.
