SUBJECT : DEACTIVATION OF RESPONSE CLUSTERS ICOW
 SUPER TYPHOON "KARDING" (I.N. NORU)

In view of the following considerations: a.) Tropical Cyclone Noru is already outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility b.) decreasing trend of evacuees and closing of most of the evacuation centers and c.) minimal requests for augmentation received from Regional DRRMCs, the following Response Clusters at the national level are hereby deactivated effective **30 September 2022, 5:00 PM**:

1. Food and Non-Food Items (FNFI) - DSWD
2. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM) - DSWD
3. Internally Displaced Persons Protection (IDPP) - DSWD
4. Health - DOH
5. Logistics - OCD
6. Search, Rescue and Retrieval (SRR) - AFP
7. Law and Order (LAO) - PNP
8. Emergency Telecommunications (ETC) - DICT
9. Education - DEPED

Further, concerned RDRRMCs are recommended to maintain the activation of Logistics, CCCM, and FNFI, and activate the Shelter and Early Recovery Clusters. With this, concerned national agencies are advised to continue monitoring the response and early recovery operations at the regional and local levels and still provide augmentation as needed. You may still submit individual agency/cluster updates to the NDRRMC as necessary.
