SUBJECT : Restoration of Water Utilities in Typhoon ODETTE
Affected Areas

This NDRRMC Memorandum is issued in compliance with the directive of the President to ensure access to clean water by the communities affected by Typhoon ODETTE. Based on the latest NDRRMC Situational Report, out of 27 cities/municipalities with disrupted water supply, only 7 have been restored, with 26% restoration. Given that it has been more than a month since the devastation of the typhoon, it can be observed that the restoration of water utilities has been considerably slow.

As discussed during the NDRRMC Response Cluster Meeting on 21 January 2022, we would like to request your good office to ensure immediate restoration of local water utilities and work with the local government units (LGUs) to report updated water status to the OCD Regional Offices.

Further, we would like to request for your submission of daily reports on water restoration efforts to the OCD via email at rocd@ocd.gov.ph and ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph.
