SUBJECT : Maintaining NDRRMOC Blue Alert Status ICOW TD "MAYMAY"


Based on the Tropical Cyclone Bulletin issued at 11:00 AM, 11 October 2022, Tropical Depression "MAYMAY" maintains its strength while moving slowly West Southwestward over the Philippine Sea East of Aurora causing heavy rains over Cagayan, Isabela, Batanes, Apayao, Aurora, Abra, Kalinga, Mountain Province, and Ilocos Norte. Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal No. 1 is currently hoisted over Isabela, Quirino, Nueva Viscaya, Aurora, Nueva Ecija and extreme northern portion of Quezon. Meanwhile, a Tropical Depression outside PAR maintains its strength as it moves Northeastward. As of 10:00 AM, 11 October 2022, the center of the Tropical Depression (outside PAR) was estimated based on all available data at 2,020 km East of Southern Luzon (14.3°N, 141.7°E).

In view of the above, the alert status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is hereby maintained to **BLUE Alert**. Thus, **continuous coordination and monitoring is heightened** effective 11 October 2022 in connection with TD "MAYMAY" and the Tropical Depression (outside PAR).
