TO : ALL CONCERNED NDRRMC MEMBER-AGENCIES AND REGIONAL DRRM COUNCILS

SUBJECT : Downgrading of the Alert Status from RED to BLUE at the NDRRMOC in connection with Tropical Cyclone "NENENG" (I.N. NESAT)

The **Red Alert Status** at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is hereby downgraded to **BLUE effective 18 October 2022**, in connection with TY "NENENG" taking into consideration the following:

- a. TC "NENENG" left PAR on 17 October 2022 at 8:00 PM.
- b. There is a decreasing trend of evacuees and closing of most of the evacuation centers as well as minimal requests for augmentation received from RDRRMCs.
- c. Deactivation of the Response Clusters for TC "NENENG" on 18 October 2022 at 5:00 PM.

However, the NDRRMOC shall maintain its BLUE Alert Status ICOW COVID-19. Further, relative to the effects of the recent tropical cyclones, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and RDRRMCs are still required to continue monitoring and to send update to NDRRMOC thru email address: ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph, telephone nrs.: **8912-5668, 8912-3046**; and/or facsimile nr.: **8911-1873**.
