Maintaining of NDRRMOC Blue Alert Status ICOW

TD "OBET"

Based on the Weather Update re Tropical Depression "OBET" conducted on 20 October 2022 at 9:00 AM and Tropical Cyclone Bulletin issued by DOST-PAGASA at 5:00 AM, The center of Tropical Depression "OBET" was estimated based on all available data 805 km East of Extreme Northern Luzon (20.5 °N, 129.7 °E) with maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 55 km/h, and is moving West Southwestward at 15 km/h. Signal No. 1 is currently raised on the provinces of Batanes, Babuyan Islands, and the northeastern portion of mainland Cagayan (Santa Ana and Gonzaga).

In this regard, the alert status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is hereby maintained to BLUE Alert. Thus, continuous coordination and monitoring is heightened effective 20 October 2022 in connection with TD "OBET"
