Raising of the Alert Status to Red of the NDRRMOC effective 26 October 2022 in connection with the Magnitude

6.7 Earthquake in Tineg, Abra

At 10:59 PM, 25 October 2022, a magnitude 6.7 earthquake occurred in 17.76°N, 120.76°E - 007 km N 58° W of Tineg (Abra) with a depth of 028 km and tectonic in origin.

In this regard, the Alert Status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is raised to RED effective 26 October 2022 to closely monitor, consolidate, and report all related incidents and to ensure prompt coordination with concerned agencies and offices.
