**SUBJECT :** DEACTIVATION OF SELECTED RESPONSE CLUSTERS and  
ACTIVATION OF EARLY RECOVERY CLUSTERS  
ICOW SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "PAENG" (I.N. NALGAE)

With the Severe Tropical Storm "Paeng" now outside the PAR and with currently minimal request for augmentation received by the NDRRMC, we now enter the early recovery period considering that the disaster response priority is already shifting from lifesaving to life sustaining. In addition, the emergency situation has been stabilized wherein conduct of various humanitarian assistance operations in the affected areas are being managed and implemented.

In line with this, the following National Response Clusters are hereby deactivated effective **04 November 2022, 08:00H:**

1. Search, Rescue and Retrieval (AFP)
2. Law and Order (PNP)
3. Emergency Telecommunications (DICT)

However, concerned RDRRMCs are recommended to maintain the activation of SRR cluster until augmentation is no longer needed.

Said Clusters are requested to submit their respective final report to DSWD at [drmb@dswd.gov.ph](mailto:drmb@dswd.gov.ph) copy furnished [dromd-group@dswd.gov.ph](mailto:dromd-group@dswd.gov.ph), NDRRMC Operations Center at [ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph](mailto:ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph), and ROCD at [rocd@ocd.gov.ph](mailto:rocd@ocd.gov.ph). Further, you may still provide updates to the NDRRMC as necessary.

Further, the Early Recovery Cluster (OCD) is hereby activated effective 04 November 2022, 08:00H in addition to the following Clusters/concerned agencies that shall remain activated under Early Recovery Phase:

1. Logistics (OCD)
2. Food and Non-Food Items (DSWD)
3. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (DSWD)
4. Internally Displaced Persons Protection (DSWD)
5. Health (DOH)
6. Education (DepEd)
7. Shelter (DHSUD)

All are advised to continue monitor and respond to the needs of the affected population from their respective emergency operation center or offices. Submit your regular reports including the **early recovery efforts**, everyday NLT 8:00PM, to NDRRM Operations Center (OCD) and DSWD through the same email addresses above.
