SUBJECT : PREPARATIONS FOR TROPICAL DEPRESSION "ROSAL" AND SHEARLINE

Based on the Weather Update conducted on 10 December 2022 at 1:00 PM, the Low Pressure Area East of Juban, Sorsogon developed into Tropical Depression "ROSAL" and expected to bring moderate to heavy with at times intense rains over Bicol Region and Quezon and moderate to heavy rains over MIMAROPA and Western Visayas. Also, Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal No. 1 is raised in the provinces of Catanduanes and the eastern portion of Camarines Sur. In this connection, you are hereby directed to undertake the following:

1. Initiate Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) with Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) Protocols at the regional level. Further, coordinate with the DILG for the LDRRMCs to conduct respective local PDRA and undertake preparedness based on Operation LISTO;
2. Monitor closely the situation and maintain continuous dissemination of warnings to the concerned LGUs.

Submit immediately PDRA results and regular RDRRMC Situation Report, as needed to the Executive Director, NDRRMC/ Administrator, OCD thru the undersigned.
