SUBJECT : Task Groups (TGs) under the Joint Task Group Emergency Preparedness and Response (JTG EPR) for "PANUNUMPA" 2022

With reference to the Committee Security Plan for "PANUNUMPA" 2022 by the Committee on Security, Peace and Order, and Emergency Preparedness and Response (CSPOEPR), the Philippine government shall implement a national-level response to ensure the safe and orderly conduct of the Inauguration of the 15<sup>th</sup> Vice-President of the Republic of the Philippines on 18 June 2022 at the Davao City Hall, Davao City; and the Inauguration of the 17<sup>th</sup> President of the Republic of the Philippines on 30 June 2022 at the National Museum of the Philippines, Manila. As part of the requirements, the Joint Task Group Emergency Preparedness (JTG EPR) has been organized under the NDRRMC to ensure safety of all event attendees and provide various emergency preparedness and response services in the case of eventualities.

As agreed during the JTG EPR Meeting on 15 June 2022, the following Task Groups (TGs) are hereby organized, with corresponding lead and member agencies involved, as follows:

1 TG Medical Emergency Management	DOH	DOH, BFP
2 TG Fire Safety and Fire Suppression	BFP	BFP
3 TG Logistics and Telecommunications	OCD	OCD, DPWH, AFP
4 TG Search, Rescue and Retrieval	AFP	AFP, BFP, MMDA
5 TG CBRNE	BFP	AFP, BFP, PNP, DOH

The TGs shall provide teams and resources to be deployed on-scene during the Inauguration of the 17<sup>th</sup> President of the Republic of the Philippines on 29 to 30 June 2022 at the National Museum of the Philippines, Manila. In this regard, the concerned agencies are hereby requested to submit **inventory/ list of personnel, teams and resources TO BE DEPLOYED ON-SCENE** as well as **personnel, teams and resources ON STANDBY**. It is important to note that the personnel and teams should be self-sustaining and should be fully vaccinated from COVID-19 (with booster shots included), as required by the Committee.

Given the urgency of the requirement by the Committee, submit the inventory/list to the OCD Operations Service (OS)-Response and Operational Coordination Division (ROCD) **not later than 16 June 2022, 12:00NN**.
