Observance of the National Disaster Resilience Month 2022

Executive Order Number 29 s. 2017 designates July of each year as the National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) throughout the country and mandates the conduct of activities relative to building of disaster resilience covering the four thematic areas: prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response, and rehabilitation and recovery.

The annual observance of the NDRM emphasizes the importance of collaboration in addressing the challenges of Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management. For this year, the NDRM theme is "Sambayanang Pilipino, Nagkakaisa tungo sa Katatagan at Maunlad na Kinabukasan". It highlights the unifying efforts of all sectors, and communities towards sustainable development.


