#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**

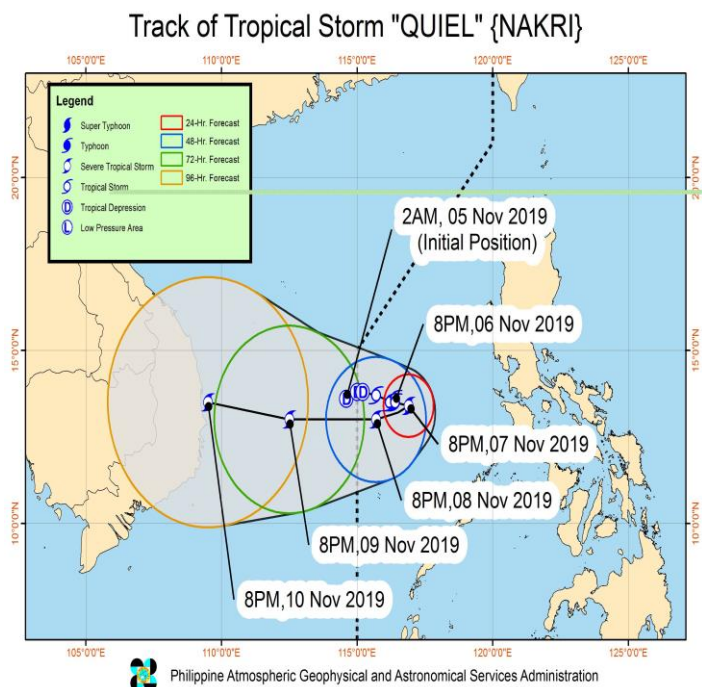
##### **A. Chronology and Tracking**

On 05 November 2019, the Tropical Depression West Southwest of Iba, Zambales entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) and was named “QUIEL”.

It intensified into a Tropical Storm on the same day while moving eastward. “QUIEL” and the Tail-End of a Cold Front (TEFC) brought moderate with occasional heavy rains over Northern Luzon particularly in Ilocos Region, Batanes, Cagayan and Apayao.

On 07 November 2019, “QUIEL” intensified into a Severe Tropical Storm (STS) while moving slowly eastward. It became a Typhoon on 8 November 2019 as it moved south-westward.

On 09 November 2019, 10:00 AM, the eye of Typhoon "QUIEL" was located at 145 km North of Pagasa Island, Palawan (Outside PAR).



## II. EFFECTS

### A. Incidents Monitored

A total of **12 incidents** were reported in Regions I, II, CAR, MIMAROPA, and VI.

#### Landslide Incident - 4

1. On 05 November 2019 a landslide incident was reported due to continuous rains in Sitio Calbario, Brgy. Pasaleng and Sitio Banquero, Brgy. Pancian, Pagudpud, Ilocos Norte. DPWH I conducted clearing operations in the area. No casualty reported.
2. On 07 November 2019, a landslide incident occurred in Brgy. Magdalena, Claveria, Cagayan A which resulted to 1 dead.
3. On 07 November 2019, a landslide incident due to heavy rains took place in Brgy. Bacan, Tubungan, which affected 1 family with 6 individuals and was temporarily Iloilo evacuated in the Barangay Hall.
4. On 07 November 2019, a landslide incident due to continuous heavy rains transpired in Kabugao, Apayao which resulted in 2 deaths and 1 injured.

#### Maritime Incident - 7

1. On 06 November 2019, 3:00 AM, a fishing boat named Three Sister with 14 passengers sunk due to inclement weather in Maria Louise Bank (Recto Bank), Spratly Islands, Palawan.
2. On 07 November 2019, a capsized motor banca was reported in due to rough seas Ansiray San Jose, Occidental Mindoro. All 12 passengers were rescued.
3. On 07 November 2019, a total of 77 motorized bancas were reported damage due to the storm surge in Barangays I, III, Harrison, Tubili, and Marikit in Paluan Occidental Mindoro.
4. On 07 November 2019, 9 fishing boats were reported damaged due to storm surge which occurred in Cabra Island, Lubang, Occidental Mindoro.
5. On 08 November 2019, 13 pump boats for fishing and 2 paddled bancas were damaged due to sea swell brought by the inclement weather in Barangay Kemdeng, San Vicente, Palawan.
6. On 08 November 2019, a sea swells caused damage to bancas owned by local fishermen in Barangays I, III, Harrison, Tubili, and Marikit in Paluan, Occidental Mindoro
7. On 11 November 2019, 1:30 AM, a survivor was recovered at the vicinity of Cabra Island, Occidental Mindoro, while 13 others were still missing.

#### Soil Erosion Incident - 1

On 07 November 2019, a soil erosion incident transpired in Camp 7, Kennon Road, Baguio City besides the river which resulted in 2 injured and brought at Baguio Gen. Hospital and Medical Center.

### B. Affected Population

- A total of **37,746 families / 154,985 persons** were affected in **321 barangays** in **Regions I, II, and CAR**.
- Of which, a total of **5,097 families / 20,404 persons** took temporary shelter in **116 evacuation centers** while **2,514 families or 9,670 persons** stayed with relatives and/or friends in **CAR**.
