Final Report on Preparedness Measures and Effects regarding the 30th Southeast Asian (SEA) Games 2019 (30 November to 12 December 2019)

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

The Philippines hosted the 30th SEA Games from 30 November to 11 December 2019. The main hub was the New Clark City Sports Village in Capas Tarlac, the secondary venue was Subic Bay Freeport Zone and the tertiary hub is within Metro Manila and other nearby areas. The venues were located in Regions I, III, CALABARZON, and NCR which were subdivided into three clusters, namely, Subic Cluster (Subic and La Union), Clark Cluster (Pampanga and Tarlac) and Metro Manila Cluster (Metro Manila, Bulacan and CALABARZON). For the entire duration of the activity, there will be 56 sports, 529 events in 43 Competition venues and 8 Non-competition venues.

It was participated by around 10,934 athletes and team officials from 11 countries (Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Singapore, Thailand, Timor-Leste, Vietnam, Philippines, Brunei, Cambodia, and Indonesia), 2,800 technical officials, 1,500 press and media attendees, 12,000 Filipino and foreign volunteers and thousands of spectators coming from different countries.

II. WEATHER CONDITION

06 December 2019

Tail-End of a Cold Front affecting the eastern section of Northern Luzon.

Cagayan Valley, Cordillera Administrative Region, and the province of Aurora will experience cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorm caused by Tail end of a Cold Front. Impacts include possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to heavy rains.

Ilocos Region will experience cloudy skies with light rains caused by the Northeast Monsoon. Metro Manila and the rest of the country will experience partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers caused by the Localized Thunderstorms.

III. EFFECTS

A. Incidents Monitored

1. On 25 November 2019, 6:15 PM, a head-butt incident during football practice occurred in Imus City Grandstand, injuring one of the foreign national athletes from Myanmar. Said athlete was immediately brought to the hospital for medical assistance.
2. On 24 November 2019, a 24-year old athlete, suffered left foot sprain during a floorball game between the Philippines vs. Thailand. The said athlete was catered by Stat Medical Ambulance at Diliman Doctors Hospital.
3. On 30 November 2019, 04:20 PM, a rear collision of 2 buses transporting Cambodian delegates transpired along the Bocaue southbound lane of North Luzon Expressway (NLEX). A total of nine (9) individuals were injured. Of which, eight (8) were Cambodians and one (1) was a Filipino.
4. On 30 November 2019, 4:25 PM, two (2) buses ferrying athletes and sports officials from Vietnam and Laos collided in Bocaue, Bulacan. One bus was carrying 40 delegates from Laos while the other bus has 42 Vietnamese delegates. The accident caused unestimated damages to both vehicles and minor injuries to ten (10) passengers. Victims were immediately given medical assistance.
5. On 30 November 2019, 7:00 AM, a protest rally was monitored at Welcome Rotonda, Brgy. Sta. Teresita, Quezon City from the Group Sentro Alliance of Filipino Workers. Said was terminated at around 09:00 AM, the same day.
6. On 30 November 2019, a protest rally was reported along Kalaw Avenue, Manila to US Embassy. The crowd is estimated to be around 200 rallyists from KMU, BAYAN, KADAMAY, and ANAK BAYAN UST groups.
7. On 30 November 2019, a protest rally transpired in CRB Mendiola with estimated crowd of 800 rallyists from the groups Socialista, NCI, PAGAWA, SANLAKAS, BMP, and Oriang.
8. On 02 December 2019, the following games were cancelled at the Subic and Pampanga Cluster due to the effects of TY "TISOY":
 - Canoe /Kayak/traditional boat race at Malawaan Park
 - Sailing/Windsurfing at Subic Yacht Club
 - Sepak Takraw at Subic Bay Gymnasium
 - Petanque at Clark, Pampanga
9. On 02 December 2019, there was a suspected food/water borne illness from the Squash and Shooting Athletes from Team Indonesia at Valero Hotel, Makati. Metro Manila-City Health Department already coordinated with RESU and EOHC. RESU mobilized regional surveillance team to do investigation and went to Valero Suites. EOHC together with Makati Sanitation Officer conducted an onsite visit. Parties from the billet and Indonesian team negated the reported incident.

10. On 05 December 2019, one (1) Filipino and (1) Singaporean had a punctured wound secondary to sea urchin sting, affected areas were cleaned. One (1) Filipina athlete was brought in Lorma Medical Center due to acute gastroenteritis.
11. On 06 December 2019, an Indonesian athlete accidentally cut-off his surfboard lace while paddling and was rescued by a Filipino surfer. Patient was safe and no consultation conducted.
12. On 09 December 2019, 1:00 PM, an athlete from Myanmar suffered left shoulder dislocation during the wrestling competition. He was transported to Angeles University Foundation Medical for treatment.
13. On 09 December 2019, 1:30 PM, an athlete from Laos suffered from rib fracture during the wrestling competition. He was transported to Angeles University Foundation Medical for treatment.

B. Casualties

As of **10 December 2019**, a total of **229 (Region I – 47 ; NCR – 182)** reported SEA Games-related injuries/medical cases were monitored in Regions I and NCR.

IV. PREPAREDNESS MEASURES

Deployed **2,357** Personnel and **1,023** assets from National/Regional Government Agencies, Local Government Units, and Private Sectors for the 30th Southeast Asian (SEA) Games 2019 coverage. **(TAB A)**

A. National DRRM Council

- a. Maintained its Blue Alert Status to monitor incidents related to the 30th SEA Games, and to ensure the timely dissemination of weather advisories and forecasts to concerned RDRRMCs, member-agencies, and Local DRRM Councils.

- a. Monitored latest weather bulletin through the PAGASA, social media, and on television.
