I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

On 15 December 2019 (Sunday), 02:11 PM, a strong Magnitude 6.9 earthquake shook the province of Davao del Sur and vicinity. The epicenter of the earthquake is located 9 kilometers northwest of Matanao, Davao del Sur at a depth of 3 kilometers. This earthquake follows the recent earthquake events (the M5.9 on 9 July 2019, the M6.3 on 16 October 2019, the M6.6 and M6.1 on 29 October, and M6.5 on 31 October) in the area. After this, a total of 530 small to moderate magnitude earthquakes have been recorded by the DOST-PHIVOLCS Philippine Seismic Network as of 1:00 PM PST of 16 December 2019.

II. EFFECTS

A. Affected Population (TAB A)

- A total of **87,094 families / 397,080 persons** were affected in **230 barangays** in Regions XI and XII.
- Of which, a total of **14,113 families/ 58,726 persons** took temporary shelter in **117 evacuation centers** while **25,565 families / 108,573 persons** were served outside ECs.

C. Damage to Infrastructures

Damaged Public Structures (TAB B.1)

A total of **79 public structures** (previous report: 48 public structures) were damaged in Regions XI and XII, of which, **19 totally damaged** and **60 partially damaged**.
