I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

The Lenten Season or *Semana Santa* is a significant annual religious observance for the Filipino Roman Catholics. It begins on Palm Sunday and continues on through Easter Sunday. During this season, people go to churches to attend mass to reflect and offer prayers.

Also, Catholics observe Spanish-influenced rituals such as processions, passion plays (*senakulo*), *pabasa*, among others. It is also an opportunity for families to spend time together.

Easter Sunday culminates the celebration of *Semana Santa*, viewed as the greatest feast of the Church year. It is one of the most festive events, a day of joy and celebration for the faithful commemorating Jesus Christ's resurrection from the dead.

II. SPECIAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE LENTEN SEASON (15 - 21 April 2019)

The easterlies was the dominating weather system in the entire archipelago during the celebration of SEMANA SANTA.

On 15-17 April 2019, the whole country had warm and humid weather condition apart from scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms in the afternoon particularly over Northern and Central Luzon.

From Maundy Thursday until Easter Sunday (18-21 April), mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms prevailed over Visayas and Mindanao due to Easterlies. The rest of the country had warm and humid weather condition apart from passing isolated rainshowers and thunderstorms in the afternoon.

Light to moderate winds from the east and southeast with slight to moderate coastal waters.

III. WEATHER CONDITION (22 April 2019, 4:00 AM)

Synopsis: Easterlies affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao

Bicol Region, Visayas and Mindanao experienced partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by Easterlies. Impacts include possible flash floods during severe thunderstorms.

Metro Manila and the rest of Luzon experienced partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers caused by localized thunderstorms. Impacts include possible flash floods during severe thunderstorms.

IV. EFFECTS

A. Incidents Monitored (TAB A)

A total of **78 incidents** were monitored in Regions I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, VIII, X, CAR, and NCR.

V. DISASTER PREPAREDNESS (TAB B)

A. National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council

1. NDRRM Operations Center (NDRRMOC)

- a. Raised the Alert Status at the NDRRM Operations Center to BLUE effective 18 April 2019, 8:00 AM.
- b. Issued Memorandum No. 39, s. 2019 on 12 April 2019 to all Chairpersons, RDRRMCs/OCD Regional Directors directing them to raise its respective Operations Centers alert status to BLUE, to continuously monitor its respective area of responsibilities (AORs), report untoward incidents to the NDRRMOC Operations Center, and undertake precautionary measures if situation warrants.
- c. Sent a memorandum to NDRRMOC Member Agencies to monitor, record, document, consolidate, and report all related incidents with various activities and actions taken by its agency and local offices in its respective AOR and to submit preparedness measures and the corresponding situational report/update thereon. A text message was also disseminated to NDRRMOC Member Agencies and RDRRMCs/OCDRCs to that effect.

2. Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils

RDRRMOC/OCDROs were on alert status to ensure the continuous and effective dissemination of weather advisories/ bulletins to RDRRMOC member-agencies, P/C/MDRRMCs, and local media (radio stations) through OCD Short Messaging System, and upload the same to social media accounts to effectively ensure public safety and achieve zero-casualty.
